READINGS AND PRAYERS FOR TRINITY SUNDAY

SENTENCE FOR THE DAY:

Proclaim the Name: 'The Lord, the Lord, a God who is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness.' *Exodus 34.6*

THE COLLECT FOR THE DAY:

Almighty and everlasting God, you have given to us your servants grace by the confession of a true faith to acknowledge the glory of the eternal Trinity, and in the power of the divine majesty to worship the Unity: keep us steadfast in this faith, and evermore defend us from all adversities, for you live and reign, one God, for ever and ever. **Amen.**

FIRST READING: EXODUS 34.1-8 LINDA BROOK MEL HUMPHREYS

The Lord said to Moses, 'Cut two tablets of stone like the former ones, and I will write on the tablets the words that were on the former tablets, which you broke. Be ready in the morning, and come up in the morning to Mount Sinai and present yourself there to me, on the top of the mountain. No one shall come up with you, and do not let anyone be seen throughout all the mountain; and do not let flocks or herds graze in front of that mountain.'

YWAM Education Study Assistance Birdathon 2023

The Education Study Assistance project run by Youth With A Mission in Vietnam enables children from very disadvantaged families to attend school by providing them with all their school books, stationery, uniforms and school fees, without which they are likely to drop out of school. It costs \$25 for each child to attend school for a whole year, and this gives them the opportunity to escape the poverty cycle. Sometimes at school she has an epileptic seizure, and must be taken to the hospital. Nguyet is strong and returns to school as soon as possible. She says every day she goes to school is a happy day, making her forget the pain of her illness. "Many thanks. These gifts are extremely valuable to me. I enjoy going to school and meeting my friends. I am happy whenever I learn something more from studying. I'm hoping for a good job in the future.".

join us in a walk around Minnippi Parklands in Tingalpa, recording all species we see or hear – more than 200 species have been recorded here, including many interesting water birds We will help with identifications. At the end of the weekend, we will work out the combined total of species.
